Trombone: Rubank (B, I, A1, A2, Sel. Studies), Remington, Bordogni, Arban, etc.

Metronome and Tuner (phone apps are acceptable)

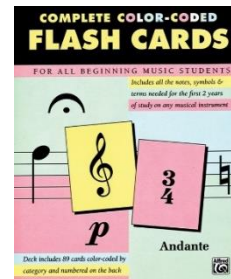
A set of music reading flash cards for beginners (Alfred Publishing)

Tuition and Attendance

Tuition is due at the first lesson of every month. I can accept cash, check, Venmo, or Zelle. If you need to miss a lesson, you must give me a minimum 24-hour notice (excluding emergencies) so that we can reschedule at no extra cost to you. Failure to do so will result in forfeiting the missed lesson. If I need to reschedule a lesson, we will reschedule it at your convenience. Regular skipping of lessons without rescheduling greatly impedes progress and could result in the student being dismissed.

Studying music can be very beneficial to many aspects of one's growth when teachers, students, and parents are all equally committed. Parents are welcome to observe lessons at any time they wish and may come and go as they please. For younger students, I encourage parents to stay and learn effective ways to help their child practice at home. Practice strategies are determined on an individual basis and are modified to fit each student's needs and goals. Parents who help their child practice can prevent the child from developing bad habits. Ten minutes of focused practice every day is much more beneficial than one hour once a week.

Remind

The app I use for mass communication is called Remind. It sends text messages to your phone. Parents can contact me by texting my personal phone number any time or calling during daylight hours. I will enroll the parents' phone in the system, and you will receive a confirmation text. This way, you can get all the necessary information quickly and efficiently.
